

Introducing your NVR Touch

Welcome! I am the **NVR Touch** from LILIN. I am the world's first standalone Network Video Recorder capable of recording 16 channels of 1080P at real time – impressive I know. I have lots of exciting new features including a brand new interactive interface, so why not set me up with a touch screen monitor and see what the future of recording looks like...

Before you get started, you might want to flick through this user introduction guide. It will help you get the best out of me, understand my basic operations and introduce you to my main icons.

1. Icons explained

These icons are always located on the top left of my live menu screen;

- Menu
- Pause
- Alarm
- Backup

These icons are located in my main menu bar;

These icons will help you exit screens, they are located on the top right of the necessary screens;


- Return to previous screen
- Return to live screen

2. Basic operations: Playback

To playback a recording, follow the simple steps below;

Enter the main menu and press the playback button

The following playback bar will appear:



Select your desired period, (year, month, day, hour, minute).

Select the time by dragging the unit selector

Once you are happy with your selection, press

Your selected recording will now appear full screen.

These are my playback controls. They will be located in a bar on the bottom of a playback screen. You can use them to navigate through a recording on screen.

Top tip:

With WYSIWYG (What You See Is What You Get) backup, all channels will be exported regardless of the on screen camera selection. Once backup has been activated, playback will slow down. If fast-forward is selected, when playing back the file the speed will be normal however the frame rate will be reduced.

3. Basic operations: Backup


You can backup and export your recordings to different media methods:

1. DVD
2. USB
3. Temporary hard drive space - an area that will save recordings which will not be overwritten until another recording is saved

To backup or export a recording, follow the simple steps below;



The following backup bar will appear:




Scroll through the dropdown box and select your required export file format.

NVR Touch

Navigate the time frame and select your desired period, (year, month, day, hour, minute).

To select your backup range, press and drag along the orange bar.

Once you have finished dragging, the backup start and backup end box will appear.



If the time period is correct, press **BACKUP** and select your export method.

If exporting to a DVD or USB, insert your device into the front panel. If exporting to your temporary hard drive space, remember previous recordings will be overwritten.

Once the export has begun, the display screen will revert back to live mode and the backup icon will illuminate, flashing with a percentage rate

You will know your export has completed when the illumination and flashing stops.

Top tip:

For all methods, when selecting backup period ensure your file size is smaller than your export device capacity. Longer periods may take more time to calculate.
